- SGA Spring Elections (increase voter turnout)—Spring
 - ❖ *Campus wide elections for all Student Government positions*
 - ❖ *Fill out Elections packet & Attend a candidates meetings to learn the rules and regulations of the election process.*

 - ❖ *Georgia Southern University Student Government Association's only on-campus attorney for currently enrolled Georgia Southern students*

 - ❖ **Location, Date, & Time: Tuesday in Centennial Place room 2112 from 3:00 pm-5:00 pm on the first floor through the doors before you get to the computer labs and classrooms. The same building as Einsteins and Cold Stone.**

- The John F. Nolen Student Government Scholarship—Spring
 - ❖ *Presented annually to selected rising undergraduate students with a 3.0 GPA or better.*
 - ❖ *The scholarship is based on co-curricular and academic performances at Georgia Southern University.*

- SGA meeting time & location as well as our Open Gallery—Fall & Spring
 - ❖ *Every Wednesday in the Russell Union Ballroom at 6:30 pm*

- Fund Requests (Collaborative & Individual Student Orgs)—Fall & Spring
 - ❖ *Organizations may be eligible for funding bi-annually (Once during the Fall semester and once during the Spring semester).*
 - ❖ *Organizations may request up to \$600 per semester; however, all funding allocations are subject to approval by the SGA Senate.*
 - ❖ *Additionally, organizations that collaboratively request funds for collaborative events may request for an additional 25% per group (\$750 each).*
 - ❖ *Money is available on a first come, first serve basis while funds are available.*
